



Policy for Self-Administered Emergency Medication

Outward Bound's Adoption of the Maine State Camps Policy for Self Administration of Emergency Medications By Students

Students are permitted to have readily available (carry or possess outside of the regular supervision of the instructors) and to self-administer emergency medications only where the following conditions are met.

- A. Any student who self-administers emergency medication must have the prior written approval of the student's primary health care provider and the student's parent or guardian;
- B. The student's parent or guardian must submit written verification to Outward Bound from the student's primary health care provider confirming that the student has the knowledge and the skills to safely self-administer the emergency medication while on course; and
- C. The Outward Bound staff must evaluate the student's technique to ensure proper and effective use of the emergency medication while on course.
